

VALSERRANO CRIANZA 2020

Comments:

The 2020 vintage was certificated by the Doca Rioja as VERY GOOD, it was characterised by unstable climate conditions, with above average precipitation and some hail. The end of the cycle was favourable and provided good balance in the ripening, giving wines with a bright, lively colour, good acidity and fruitiness.

Vinification and ageing:

Made from grapes of the Tempranillo 95% and Mazuelo 5% varieties.

Aged for 18 months in American- and French-oak casks and stored for several months in the vat for good blending of the wine before it was bottled.

Tasting notes:

- **COLOUR**: Medium-depth, garnet red colour with slight evolution towards ruby.
- AROMA: With the glass still, nuances of coconut, cinnamon, wild berries such as blackberries, and spicy notes. When swirled in the glass, nuances of mint, liquorice and chocolate appear, with reminders of cedar wood and graphite.
- MOUTH: A creamy, lively attack. As it passes through the mouth you can detect flavours reminiscent of cherry liqueur and it has a powerful aftertaste, with juicy tannins and good length.
